YOU ARE INVOLVED IN, OR HAVE SEEN, AN INCIDENT AFLOAT.



CONTACT THE EMERGENCY SERVICES  
MAYDAY OR 999.

*Portaferry lifeboat can attend and control a life threatening situation in minutes.*

REPORT THE INCIDENT TO THE ACTIVITY LEADER.

*This may be the OOD 'Officer of the Day, Training Instructor or another member of the club.*

*Communicate by radio, mobile phone, shouting, waving your arms, torchlight, flare ...*

IF THERE IS NO-ONE ELSE AVAILABLE THEN YOU ARE THE 'RESPONSIBLE PERSON'.

TAKE ACTION TO PRESERVE LIFE.

*E.g. First Aid...*

PREVENT FURTHER HARM.

CONTACT THE CLUB ASHORE 028 44 828375 TO ASSIST:  
*The House Duty Officer can take charge ashore and alert others by ringing the bar bell and asking for help to:*

1. MANAGE CASUALTIES AT THE PONTOON.
2. DIRECT OTHER EMERGENCY SERVICES FROM THE ROAD.
3. IF REQUIRED LAUNCH AVAILABLE AND APPROPRIATE SAFETY CRAFT; E.G. WORKBOAT OR RIB.
4. MONITOR COMMUNICATIONS.

END THE PLANNED ACTIVITY AND ACCOUNT FOR ALL PERSONS

LIAISE WITH EMERGENCY SERVICES, IF IN ATTENDANCE

INFORM AN EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEMBER
