## Notice Of Race

### **Rules**

The East Down Yacht Club Peel Race 2016 shall be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing*, and by the Sailing Instructions available on the EDYC website [www.edyc.co.uk](http://www.edyc.co.uk).

### **Eligibility**

The event is open to all yachts registered with the Strangford Lough Regatta Conference in the following classes: IRC, NHC, Restricted sail

Class 1 - IRC yachts - Numeral Pennant 1

Class 2 - NHC yachts - Numeral Pennant 2

Class 3 - NHC Restricted Sail yachts – Numeral Pennant 3

**Strangford Lough Regatta Conference** has adopted the NHC as the performance handicap system for cruisers and sports-boats. NHC Handicaps will be electronically adjusted in accordance with RYA guidelines after each race. The adjusted handicaps will be used as the NHC handicap for the next race. Boats will remain in their respective classes for the entire series.

If no NHC handicap is recorded on the SLRC database it is the Yacht owner's responsibility to obtain one through his club sailing secretary.

IRC Boats must have a valid 2016 certificate.

|--------------|------------------------|------------------|
| Class 3      | 11:10                  | Numeral 3        |
| Class 2      | 11:20                  | Numeral 2        |
| Class 1      | 11:30                  | Numeral 1        |

**Fee**

There will be a £10 entry fee.

**Insurance and Liability**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.

**Decision to Race**

Competitors participate in the race entirely at their own risk. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Series.
