

EDYC. BOAT SHED SECURITY

East Down Yacht Club is a self-help club. Every member should take responsibility for the security of the new shed. If the shed doors are open and there is nobody around, please close them. This includes the large sliding door. Take time out to find out how this is done. This is especially important in the evening.

The new CCTV cameras are active 24/7 recording all activity in the vicinity of the shed.

The new procedure for getting into the boat shed is as follows.

UNLOCKING THE DOORS OF THE BOAT SHED

There are three doors in the shed. Two side doors and one large sliding door at the front.

The side doors have TWO LOCKS. The existing mechanical lock that is opened with the code buttons, and a new electro magnetic lock linked to the ALARM.

BOTH locks have to be unlocked to gain entry. The procedure is:-

Existing mechanical lock first. Press c. To clear. Enter code, press Y, turn the handle.

At the same time present your MEMBERSHIP CARD to the new card reader. (labelled CARD READER)

Open the door with the handle.

The existing lock is every effective, strong and expensive

DO NOT FORCE THE DOOR. IT WILL OPEN. If you set off the alarm accidentally, simply present your card to the card reader, this will silence the alarm.

You should now be inside. The side doors are on self closers. To open the side door from the inside present your membership card to the reader, (labelled CARD READER). Open the door and exit.

LOCKING THE SHED

If you are last to leave and wish to lock up and set the alarm, the procedure is,

Step one, Make sure the large sliding door is closed and locked using the padlock.

Step two. Use the side door nearest to the clubhouse. That is where the light switches are.

There is a white key pad with a flap, (labelled ALARM) to the right of the door.

Touch the keypad to activate it. Type 2222. Set A. YES

Present your card to the card reader, (Labelled card reader), to open the door. Turn off the lights as you exit. A CONFIRMING ALARM SOUND WILL BE HEARD.

If you have any difficulties operating the locks/alarm, or if your card does not unlock the door contact me on 07898778319. A lot of time and effort has gone into making this new boat shed a wonderful asset for the club. Please do your part and keep it secure and tidy.

FAQ

Q. Is the system easy to use?

A. Yes – A card and a number will enable entry

Q. Does this set of instructions enable anyone to enter the shed?

A. No to enter the shed when locked you need the keylock number and your gate/membership card

Q. Can I be locked or trapped in the shed?

A. No there is an emergency exit system – a green break glass type panel (adjacent to the doors) which when activated will release the door. Please do not use this unless an emergency as it requires to be reset.

Q. Do the cameras work in darkness?

A. Yes
