Club RS Feva and Topper Sailing Dinghy EDYC Usage Policy

1. These boats are only to be used with permission of a member of Sailing Committee.

If you are granted permission to use a boat, then you must first sign the Feva/Topper logbook which is located on the back wall, above the rudder rack if the green shed at the head of the slipway. Please note in the book the Feva/Topper hull number. This must be done each time you use a Feva/Topper. We are required at the end of the season to account for the usage of these boats.

- 2. Anyone using the boats must wear personal buoyancy at all times.
- 3. The boats are only to be used whenever a safety boat is in attendance such as at club training activities or club racing.

(Other use may be granted by express permission of the sailing committee on request but will require payment of a facility fee of £20 per Feva and £10 per Topper for each day's use.)

4. Responsibility for damages

In order to maintain these boats in the best possible condition we would ask that you check the boat over carefully before taking it out and note any damages or faults in the logbook. If you damage the boat or its equipment when using it, then this must also be recorded in the logbook whenever you come off the water. This must also be notified to any of the Sailing Committee.

(If the damage is substantial then the club will require you to pay the first £150.00 of the repair cost).
